Developers for all types of graphic and non-graphic software were busy harnessing the then quite limited power of computers, and in most cases ease of use was not a priority. Since then the international acceptance and reliance on computers has changed the way we all live and work. Large and small software companies are racing to "out-tech" each other. Established software programs are continually being upgraded and new innovative products are launched, but very few are really designed with the daily needs and the logic of the user in mind.

Lynda Holler began her twenty-five year career in the fashion industry when colored markers, graph paper and foam core boards were a designer's primary tools. As computers proved their value, she began learning common programs like MS Word and Excel but was continually frustrated with the illogical steps and unhelpful Help messages that were part of the process.

Surrounded by the image, color and pattern of the fashion world, Holler became a loyal Colour Matters software user. She found the color, drawing and manipulation tools to be fast and easy to use and didn't have time in her busy life to learn the complicated terminology and cumbersome steps of programs like Adobe Photoshop.
